No scorecards will be provided, all scoring will be live via the “Golf Genius” App. Please download to your phone prior to arriving for your tee time. Your GGID (Golf Genius Identification number) will be provided prior to the event.

Please arrive No Earlier than 30 minutes prior to your tee time.

Non-metallic spikes are mandatory. All participants require proper attire, No Jeans

COVID-19 related Safety Measures & Guidelines for Golf Outing Events at NACC

The New Albany Country Club Team is delighted to welcome back Events to the Club's Golf Course & Catering Spaces. We are eager to serve you and will be strictly observing the mandated sanitization and social distancing protocols as established for Restaurants and Golf Courses, in accordance with the Ohio Department of Health's Covid-19 guidelines. We have parameters that we must abide by and have taken every precaution to keep you safe and healthy. Among many implemented procedures are the following:

- All employees are required to perform daily symptom assessment and stay home if symptomatic. Upon arrival to work all staff undergo a temperature check and are obligated to wash their hands frequently throughout shifts.
- All service staff have undergone ServSafe education and are well trained in safely handling food & beverages.

- Facial coverings are mandatory for all employees while on Club property.
- Gloves are required for all staff while handling food & beverages. Fresh gloves are to be worn with each course and when switching between clearing and serving items.
- High touch surfaces all throughout the Club are on a regular cleaning schedule.
- Face Masks are mandatory while on Club property in all indoor as well as outdoor areas. Masks may be removed while seated at designated tables to consume food and beverage or while sharing a golf cart with people living in the same household. During Golf, if at least 6ft of distance cannot be maintained, masks are required.
- Congregating of guests is prohibited by State Order. Guest arrival times need to be staggered and guests encouraged to arrive no more than 30min prior to their tee time. Social distancing is required at registration as well as during the wait for the tee time. Floorplans should be devoid of "gathering" areas as much as possible. Activities that would encourage guests to mingle have to be avoided.
- Limited Driving Range Station availability.
- All scoring will be done using the golf genius app. Golfers are to download the app in advance of play.
- All on-course beverages and snacks are offered through staffed Bev Carts only – communal beverage stations cannot be accommodated.
- Post round Boxed Meals will be served in a pre-determined location - guests should be encouraged to enjoy their meal and depart, making room for the arrival of the next wave of golfers.
- Tables & chairs will be sanitized between occupants.
- A maximum of 8 guests can be seated per 60" Round table – tables of 4 guests (keeping foursomes together) are preferred to maximize social distance.
- Guest Tables will be placed at least 6ft apart.
- All food & beverages must be consumed while seated at assigned tables. No food & beverages are allowed on the ballroom balconies.
- Meal offerings are served in a boxed fashion.
- Bars are permitted, social distancing guidelines must be followed while standing in line and guests must return to their seat immediately after receiving their beverage.
- Hand Sanitation Stations will be available.

Please remember that the risk of contracting COVID-19 remains. The Club has taken, and will continue to take, steps to reduce the risk of contracting the virus while at the Club. Despite these measures, the Club cannot eliminate the risk of contracting the virus at the Club. Each event host and their respective guests will have to make their own decisions about what offerings to utilize and precautions to take to lessen the risk of contracting the virus. By using the Club and participating in its offerings each host, guest and their families are assuming all risk related to the pandemic including the risk of contracting the virus and agree to hold the Club harmless and without liability with regard to the same.

I-270 toward Wheeling
Take exit 30 for OH-161 East toward New Albany
Take exit for Hamilton Road
Turn right on Hamilton Road (South)
At intersection of Dublin-Granville Road and Hamilton Road, turn left (East)
Follow Dublin-Granville Road to Greensward Road
Turn right (south) onto Greensward Road (through the New Albany Communities)
Follow Greensward Road approximately 1 mile to Club Lane
Turn right (South) on Club lane into New Albany Country Club

From the South

I-270 toward Cleveland
Take exit 33 towards Easton
Take exit 30 for OH-161 East toward New Albany
Take exit for Hamilton Road
Turn right on Hamilton Road (South)
At intersection of Dublin-Granville Road and Hamilton Road, turn left (East)
Follow Dublin-Granville Road to Greensward Road
Turn right (south) onto Greensward Road (through the New Albany Communities)
Follow Greensward Road approximately 1 mile to Club Lane
Turn right (South) on Club lane into New Albany Country Club

From Downtown

I-670 East
Continue onto US-62 East
Take the exit on the left onto I-270 N toward US-62 E/Cleveland/Gahanna
Take exit 33 towards Easton
Take exit 30 for OH-161 East toward New Albany
Take exit for Hamilton Road
Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Hamilton Road South and merge onto Hamilton Road South
Turn left (East) onto East Dublin Granville Road
Follow East Dublin-Granville Road to Greensward Road
Turn right (South) onto Greensward Road (through the New Albany Communities)
Follow Greensward Road approximately 1 mile to Club Lane
Turn right (South) on Club lane into New Albany Country Club
